Ezer: (Ay-zer) noun: help, helper Appears in 21 verses. 16 times referring to God, 2 times to woman, 3 times to a superior force or army coming to Isreal's aid.

[Gen 2:18 ESV] Then the LORD God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a **helper** fit for him."

[Gen 2:20 ESV] The man gave names to all livestock and to the birds of the heavens and to every beast of the field. But for Adam there was not found a **helper** fit for him.

[Exo 18:4 ESV] and the name of the other, Eliezer (for he said, "The God of my father was my **help**, and delivered me from the sword of Pharaoh").

[Deu 33:7 ESV] And this he said of Judah: "Hear, O LORD, the voice of Judah, and bring him in to his people. With your hands contend for him, and be a **help** against his adversaries."

[Deu 33:26 ESV] "There is none like God, O Jeshurun, who rides through the heavens to your **help**, through the skies in his majesty.

[Deu 33:29 ESV] Happy are you, O Israel! Who is like you, a people saved by the LORD, the shield of your **help**, and the sword of your triumph! Your enemies shall come fawning to you, and you shall tread upon their backs."

[Psa 20:2 ESV] May he send you **help** from the sanctuary and give you support from Zion!

[Psa 33:20 ESV] Our soul waits for the LORD; he is our **help** and our shield.

[Psa 70:5 ESV] But I am poor and needy; hasten to me, O God! You are my **help** and my deliverer; O LORD, do not delay!

[Psa 89:19 ESV] Of old you spoke in a vision to your godly one, and said: "I have granted **help** to one who is mighty; I have exalted one chosen from the people.

[Psa 115:9 ESV] O Israel, trust in the LORD! He is their **help** and their shield.

[Psa 115:10 ESV] O house of Aaron, trust in the LORD! He is their **help** and their shield.

[Psa 115:11 ESV] You who fear the LORD, trust in the LORD! He is their **help** and their shield.

[Psa 121:1 ESV] A Song of Ascents. I lift up my eyes to the hills. From where does my **help** come?

[Psa 121:2 ESV] My **help** comes from the LORD, who made heaven and earth.

[Psa 124:8 ESV] Our **help** is in the name of the LORD, who made heaven and earth.

[Psa 146:5 ESV] Blessed is he whose **help** is the God of Jacob, whose hope is in the LORD his God,

[Isa 30:5 ESV] everyone comes to shame through a people that cannot profit them, that brings neither **help** nor profit, but shame and disgrace."

[Eze 12:14 ESV] And I will scatter toward every wind all who are around him, his **helpers** and all his troops, and I will unsheathe the sword after them.

[Dan 11:34 ESV] When they stumble, they shall receive a little **help**. And many shall join themselves to them with flattery,

[Hos 13:9 ESV] He destroys you, O Israel, for you are against me, against your **helper**.
