1. Rhythm 1 - Pursue - "Follow the Star".
Psalm 1:1, "Blessed is the man who does not walk . . . stand . . . sit"

What does it **mean** to "Pursue"?

Merriam Webster - "to find or employ measures to obtain or accomplish; to proceed along (a course); to follow in order to catch up with and seize; **to seek.**

Wise Men In "Pursuit" - Holy & Sacred.

Matthew 2:1-2,"1. After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem 2. and asked, "Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him."

The Wise Men - Three Lessons & One Question.

- 1 The Wise Men had to "Look Up to Move Forward". v.2,
- 2 They were given a "Direction" not a "Destination." v. 1,
- 3 They asked questions till they found the "Holy & Sacred". v. 2

They asked the One Question Wise Men Ask . . . "Where is he who is born King of the Jews?"

2. Rhythm 2 - Read - "Rhythm the Book". **Psalm 1:2a,** "But his **Delight** is in the Law of the Lord . . . "


"Delight" means . . . "To bend toward, be drawn in, to find joy".

"Delight" is assumed to be constant; never ending; all the time. It's the difference between a "workout" and a "rhythm."

Psalm 19:10-11, "The decrees of the Lord are firm, and all of them are righteous. They are **more precious than gold**, than much pure gold; they are **sweeter than honey,** than honey from the honeycomb. By them your servant is warned; **in keeping them there is great reward."**

Deuteronomy 32:46-47, "he said to them, "Take to heart all the words I have solemnly declared to you this day, so that you may command your children to obey carefully all the words of this law. They are not just idle words for you—**they are your life.** By them you will live long in the land you are crossing the Jordan to possess."

LION OF GOD, A Biography of John G. Mitchell, DD John G. Mitchell, DD founded Central Bible Church in 1942. It became the largest church west of the Mississippi until he retired in 1967. He founded Central Bible Church and Multnomah School of The Bible and radio preaching. He was best known for his knowledge of the scripture. He could quote scripture for hours without looking. His secret? For the entirety of his ministry, before he preached on a passage of scripture, he would read the book from which it was taken, in its entirety, fifty times. Fifty times! He is quoted as saying, "I never set out to memorize the Bible, I just read it so much that I knew it by heart."



"Living Prayer", page 23,28, "Just as the end result of all our interaction with the Word should be mediation, so also the end result of meditation should be prayer. In fact, the final part of meditation is prayer. Meditation begins with **pondering** the text, then moves to **personalizing** it, and concludes with **praying** the text back to God . . . Prayer does not start in the heart or with your feelings, it begins with the Word of God . . Without meditation on God's Word, your prayers run the risk of being shallow, short sighted and self focused."

California Redwood Trees

VS.

Israeli Negev Acacia Tree

"Water" in Psalm 1... can mean a "river", it can also mean, "source". Meaning a source of water above ground but also can mean a source of water below ground.

The Acacia Tree. Grows in harsh environments; has green leaves year round and fruit in season. It's roots go deep to find water that no one sees. Which is why God had Moses and the Israelites make all the Tabernacle furniture and equipment out of Acacia wood and then covered it in gold.

You have to **Grow Deep**; before you **Grow Up**.

2 Peter 1:5-8, For this very reason, **make every effort** to add to your **faith goodness**; and to goodness, **knowledge**; and to knowledge, **self-control**; and to self-control, **perseverance**; and to perseverance, **godliness**; and to godliness, **mutual affection**; and to mutual affection, **love**.
